6.4.2.4 Delete the clause entirely. Substitute:

Any PE pipe shall be completely sleeved with fire retardant glass reinforced plastic and secured with wall-mounted retaining clips or as instructed by the manufacturer or any proprietary systems.

Clause

11.2.2 Delete Note 1 entirely. Substitute:

Note 1: Insulating fittings complying with DIN 3389-1 are suitable for use inside buildings. Fittings complying solely with GIS/E17-2 are not suitable for use inside buildings. Fittings which are intended for use inside buildings need to be resistant to high temperatures in accordance with Annex A of BS EN 1775.
